

Access to Lake Brantley

As a SWC resident you have legal access to Lake Brantley's beaches and boat ramp and Sweetwater Oaks tennis courts, however there is a fee. The access fee has been reduced to \$15 which is due at registration. Proof of residency will be required annually for renewal. Registration can be completed at the Sweetwater Oaks office located at 810 Fox Valley Drive. Hours are 9am to 4 pm M-F. It is a good idea to call ahead and verify that the office is staffed. Phone number is 407-862-5606. There is also a club house adjacent to the office that is available to rent for parties

From SWC travel east along Wekiva Springs Rd., turn right at the 2ND Sweetwater Blvd S. Turn left on Blue Lake Dr., then left on Palmetto Ct.

Trash and Yard Waste Collection

Our refuse collection is paid on our property tax bills and our choices are updated annually. The schedule is:

Household Garbage	Monday and Thursday	No quantity limit
Recycling	Monday	No quantity limit
Yard Waste	Wednesday	Quantity limited

For more information, please call 407-665-2260. Please remember that NO COLLECTION WILL BE MADE on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas or July 4th.

Please be considerate of your neighbors and do not put any refuse collection out prior to the night before scheduled pickup. In the interest of bear awareness, **please use only Bear-Proof cans for garbage**. Yard waste should not be placed on any curb until the night before collection. All containers should be removed from sight the day of collection. Your considerate cooperation will be appreciated by all.

Stray Animals

New residents, please accept this reminder that SWC adheres to the Seminole County ordinances regarding pets. This means that all pets must be either confined to your property or on a leash when off your property. So, pet owners, PLEASE register your pets so that we can identify them. That will allow us to accurately identify the pet and inform the pet's owner to secure their immediate cooperation. Like most neighborhood problems, we can solve this one if we just work together.

Lawn Watering Schedule

There is no watering permitted on any day between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

November 2 – March 7: Even addresses water on Sunday; odd addresses water on Saturday

March 8 – November 1: Even addresses water Thursday & Sunday; odd water Wednesday & Saturday
